What is Reach Out?

Reach Out is a collaborative effort of the Northeast Ohio Chapter of the Association of Corporate Counsel -America (NEOACCA); the Federal Bar Association, Northern District of Ohio Chapter; and the Cleveland Metropolitan Bar Association (CMBA), all of which have teamed up to develop and provide valuable law-related education and pro bono legal assistance to nonprofit organizations in Northeast Ohio whose missions focus on community service and who demonstrate financial need.

For nonprofits: A series of free educational seminars will provide nonprofit leaders with information on various legal issues of importance to their organizations. Nonprofits will be matched with volunteer attorneys following the seminar for a brief advice and counseling session. If the services of a transactional lawyer appear to be needed, the matter may be referred to a lawyer willing to accept referrals.

For lawyers: Lawyers will receive free CLE credits at each educational seminar they attend with the goal of educating them to provide services in three ways: (1) serving as faculty in law-related education programs, (2) providing brief advice and counseling at designated clinics, and/or (3) accepting referrals for pro bono service on transactional legal matters, and in some cases, litigation.
