What is Reach Out?

Nonprofits face many of the same complexities as commercial businesses, and sometimes more, but often lack resources. Reach Out is designed to provide pro bono legal services to and free law-related education for area nonprofit organizations whose missions focus on community service and who demonstrate financial need.

For nonprofits: A series of educational seminars will provide nonprofit leaders with information on various legal issues of importance to their organizations. Nonprofits will be matched with volunteer attorneys following the seminar for a brief advice and counseling session. If the services of a transactional lawyer appear to be needed, the matter may be referred to a lawyer willing to accept referrals.

For lawyers: Lawyers will receive free CLE credits at each educational seminar they attend with the goal of educating them to provide services in three ways: (1) serving as faculty in law-related education programs, (2) providing brief advice and counseling at designated clinics, and/or (3) accepting referrals for pro bono service on transactional legal matters, and in some cases, litigation.
