We are pleased to bring you an exciting and diverse line-up, with Professor Reginald Oh presenting on bias in the criminal justice system; Christian Grostic on the Sixth Circuit Review; and Professor Mike Benza will give the annual Supreme Court Review. A video presentation by Allison Siegler "*Breaking Out of the Cage*," will be followed by a panel discussion on litigating pretrial detention by attorneys Ian N. Friedman, Timothy C. Ivey, Carolyn M.
